

The Church of our Lady in the centre of the city has a 122 meter tower and remains one of the largest brick built buildings in the world The city-center Markt features horsedrawn carriage rides and 17th-century houses converted into restaurants and cafes, as well as the 13th-century belfry with its 47-bell carillon and 83m tower with panoramic views..

No trip to Bruges would be complete without sampling the artisanal skill of both the chocolatier and the beer makers. With over 50 chocolatiers at work showcasing both traditional skills and boundary pushing creativity you are truly spoilt for choice.





### Places to visit

#### The Markt

Take time out to sit in the Markt in the heart of Bruges, watch the world go by and take in the gothic splendour of the buildings. The Medieval Belfry has wonderful views of the city, once you have climbed the 366 steps to the top. The alternative perspective of this beautiful city Basilica is said to house Christ's blood, which is paraded around in a grand procession as part of the Ascension day festivities.

#### Canal Tours

Historically the canals and water ways of Bruges have been of great importance and integral to the cities growth over the centuries. Taking a leisurely, guided boat tour gives you an
