

Spain, Leon

León, a city on the Bernesga River in northwest Spain, is the capital of the Province of León. It's home to many churches and cathedrals noted for their architecture and art. Among them is the Gothic 13th-century Catedral de Léon, with its towers and flying buttresses. The 10th-century Romanesque Basílica de San Isidoro is known for its frescoes and royal tombs.

The capital city León celebrates the Fiestas of San Juan in June (21st - 30th) with processions and bullfights organised during the day and open-air music concerts, bonfires, fireworks and partying at night. The Easter Week processions in León are famous, especially the Good Friday march through the historical center of the city.

León's heyday was in the 10th to 12th centuries when it was capital of the Kingdom of León. During this medieval period, León was an important stop on the Way of Saint James for pilgrims traveling to Santiago de Compostela. The monastery where the pilgrims stayed has been converted into a luxurious Parador hotel. Other remarkable monuments include the 11th-century Collegiate Church of Saint Isidore and the magnificent Gothic cathedral with its spectacular stained-glass windows. León is famous for its regional gastronomy, and hidden among the city's charming cobblestone streets are lively little tapas restaurants that serve delicacies such as cured meats and croquettes.



Places to visit

Cathedral de Leon (Santa Maria de Regla)

This gothic-era cathedral of golden sandstone with soaring stained glass windows and richly decorated west portals is a must see. Take a self guided tour around the cathedral and view some stunning architecture.

Museo de Arte Contemporáneo

This showpiece has been acclaimed for the 37 shades of Coloured glass that adorn the facade. The airy galleries mostly display temporary displays of cutting-edge Spanish and international photography, video installations and other similar forms. It also has a growing permanent collection.
